

ONE YEAR BEFORE OR LESS THAN ~~[[15]]~~ 45 DAYS PRIOR TO AN ELECTION FOR WHICH A PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION IS SOUGHT, MAY BE MATCHED. A PRIVATE CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION TO A CANDIDATE FOR A PUBLICLY ELECTED POLITICAL PARTY OFFICE MAY NOT BE MATCHED.

(C) APPLICATION FOR PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION.

WHEN MAKING APPLICATION FOR A PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION, A CANDIDATE SHALL SUBMIT TO THE STATE BOARD A MATCHING PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION VOUCHER OF A FORM PRESCRIBED BY THE STATE BOARD, AND THE CANDIDATE SHALL INCLUDE ON THE FORM THE FULL NAME AND ADDRESS OF EACH CONTRIBUTOR AND THE DATE AND AMOUNT OF EACH CONTRIBUTION.

(D) AMOUNTS OF PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION.

ON SATISFYING THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SECTION RELATING TO SEED MONEY, A CANDIDATE IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE FOR EACH PRIVATE CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTION OF NOT MORE THAN \$50 FROM EACH INDIVIDUAL PERSON MATCHING PAYMENTS IN THE FOLLOWING RATIOS FOR CANDIDATES FOR:

(1) STATEWIDE OFFICE -- A \$3 PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION FOR EACH \$1 OF ELIGIBLE PRIVATE CONTRIBUTIONS, BUT THE TOTAL MAY NOT EXCEED AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 75 PERCENT OF THE MAXIMUM PRIMARY ELECTION LIMIT PROVIDED IN SECTION 30-3~~[[.]]~~, EXCEPT THAT A CANDIDATE FOR A PUBLICLY ELECTED POLITICAL PARTY OFFICE MAY NOT RECEIVE A PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION.

(2) NON-STATEWIDE OFFICE -- A \$2 PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION FOR EACH \$1 OF ELIGIBLE PRIVATE CONTRIBUTIONS, BUT THE TOTAL MAY NOT EXCEED AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO 66 2/3 PERCENT OF THE MAXIMUM PRIMARY ELECTION LIMIT PROVIDED IN SECTION 30-3~~[[.]]~~, EXCEPT THAT A CANDIDATE FOR A PUBLICLY ELECTED POLITICAL PARTY OFFICE MAY NOT RECEIVE A PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION.

[[30-6. PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION IN A GENERAL ELECTION.

(A) ENTITLEMENT TO PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION IN A GENERAL ELECTION THE NOMINEE OF A:

(1) MAJOR PARTY IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE MAXIMUM PUBLIC CONTRIBUTION;

(2) MINOR PARTY OR AN INDEPENDENT CANDIDATE WHO HAS COMPLIED WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS TITLE FOR PLACING HIS NAME ON THE BALLOT IS ENTITLED TO RECEIVE THE GREATER OF EITHER:

(I) AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO THE MAXIMUM PUBLIC
