member to the Council and removing the Commissioner as an ex officio member, revising the method of appointing the chairman of the Council, deleting an obsolete provision relating to the initial terms of members of the Council, providing for per diem allowances and expenses for members of the Council, increasing the duties of the Council, requiring approval by the Council of certain apprenticeship and on-the-job training programs and establishing the procedure for such approval, prohibiting the operation of certain such programs without approval by the Council, providing penalties for violations thereof, repealing the requirement of approval over such programs by the State Board of Education and the State Superintendent of Schools, and generally relating to the Apprenticeship and Training Council and to apprenticeship and on-the-job training programs.
