INDUSTRY.

- (F) IF AN INSPECTION DISCLOSES THAT AN ELEVATOR IS UNSAFE AND THAT ITS CONTINUED OPERATION WILL VIOLATE ANY RULE, REGULATION, STANDARD OR CODE PROMULGATED AND ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBTITLE, A CITATION AND PENALTIES MAY BE ISSUED IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 36 AND SECTION 37 OF THIS SUBTITLE.
- (G) EVERY ELEVATOR, DUMBWAITER, ESCALATOR AND MOVING WALK SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN A SAFE OPERATING CONDITION AND IN CONFORMITY WITH THE APPLICABLE ANSI STANDARD, A17.1 AND ANY SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS THERETO AND ANY RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE A DOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY.]]
- ALL NEW AND EXISTING ELEVATORS, DUMBWAITERS, ESCALATORS AND MOVING WALKS SHALL BE INSPECTED, TESTED AND MAINTAINED IN A SAFE OPERATING CONDITION AS PRESCRIBED BY THE AMERICAN NATIONAL STANDARD SAFETY CODE FOR ELEVATORS, DUMBWAITERS, ESCALATORS AND MOVING WALKS AND KNOWN AS ANSI A17.1 - 1971, AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS TO IT, AND ANY RULES AND REGULATIONS AS MAY BE ADOPTED BY THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY. HOWEVER, ANY ELEVATOR, DUMEWAITER, ESCALATOR, AND MOVING WALK INSTALLED BEFORE JULY 1, 1955 MAY BE USED WITHOUT BEING ALTERED OR REBUILT TO COMPLY WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ANSI CODE. HOWEVER, ALL ELEVATORS SHALL BE EQUIPPED WITH STANDARD HOISTWAY ENTRANCE PROTECTION, AND ALL PASSENGER ELEVATORS OF MORE THAN 100 FEET PER MINUTE CONTRACT SPEED SHALL BE PROVIDED WITH CAR DOORS OR GATES WHICH MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ANSI CODE A17.1 - 1971 AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS TO IT. NOTWITHSTANDING THE AFOREGOING, ALL ELEVATORS, DUMBWAITERS, ESCALATORS AND MOVING WALKS INSTALLED BEFORE JULY 1, 1955 SHALL BE MAINTAINED IN A SAFE OPERATING CONDITION SO AS NOT TO CREATE A SUBSTANTIAL PROBABILITY OF SERIOUS PHYSICAL HARM OR DEATH AND SHALL BE SUBJECT TO INSPECIONS AND TESTS AS REQUIRED.
- ALL ALTERATIONS AND RELOCATIONS OF ELEVATORS, DUMBWAITERS, ESCALATORS AND MOVING WALKS, INSTALLED SUBSEQUENT TO THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF THIS ACT SHALL MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ANSI CODE A17.1 1971 AND ALL SUBSEQUENT AMENDMENTS AND REVISIONS TO IT.
- THE COMMISSIONER OF LABOR AND INDUSTRY SHALL ADMINISTER AND ENFORCE THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION AND SHALL PRESCRIBE RULES AND REGULATIONS HE DEEMS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT HIS RESPONSIBILITY UNDER THIS SECTION.
- (F) WHEN AN INSPECTION DISCLOSES THAT AN ELEVATOR
 IS IN UNSAFE CONDITION SO THAT ITS CONTINUED OPERATION
 WILL VIOLATE ANY RULE, REGULATION, STANDARD OF CODE
