vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.

7-601.

(b) Unless the will provides a larger measure of compensation, upon petition filed in reasonable detail by the personal representative or special administrator the court may allow the Commissions it considers appropriate. The Commissions shall not exceed those computed in accordance with the table in this subsection.
