awarded to it shall thereafter be awarded by the Racing Commission to the Southern Maryland Agricultural Fair Association of Prince George's County in addition to the number of racing days then awardable to the Southern Maryland Agricultural Fair Association of Prince George's pursuant to Section 15(a) of this provided, however, that no dates awarded pursuant to this section shall conflict with any other dates for racing in Prince George's County. If the license and dates are provided above in this subsection. awarded as Southern Maryland Agricultural Fair Association of Prince George's County for a period of ten years shall pay such amount as shall be reviewed by the Racing Commission, but in no case less than six thousand dollars (\$6,000.00) per racing day to the State Comptroller for each racing day transferred; from these payments the State Comptroller for a period of eight years shall pay the sum of one hundred eight thousand dollars (\$108,000.00) each year to the Agricultural and Mechanical Association of Washington if that association operates a fair in the particular year; and the remainder of the moneys received Comptroller Maryland the from the Southern Agricultural Fair Association of Prince George's County shall be credited to the general funds of the treasury. PRIOR TO ANY SALE OF THE MARLBORO TRACK OR FACILITIES THEREOF BY THE JOINT VENTURE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION THE PERSON OR PERSONS SO AUTHORIZED OFFER TO SELL THE MARLBORO TRACK AND FACILITIES OR ANY INTEREST THEREIN TO PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY ON THE SAME A PROSPECTIVE PURCHASER WHICH AS TO SHALL CONSTITUTE THE RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL BY THE PRINCE ANY OTHER COUNTY COUNCIL. NOTWITHSTANDING GEORGE'S PROVISIONS OF THIS ARTICLE, THE LICENSE AND DATES RACING AWARDED TO THE JOINT VENTURE DESCRIBED IN THIS SUBSECTION AND TO THE SOUTHERN MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL FAIR ASSOCIATION OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY[[, IN ADDITION NUMBER OF RACING DAYS AWARDABLE TO THE SOUTHERN MARYLAND AGRICULTURAL FAIR ASSOCIATION OF PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY 11 UNDER SECTION 15 (A) OF THIS ARTICLE, RUN AT THE BOWIE TRACK, IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PROVISIONS [[OF SECTIONS 15 AND 16]] OF THIS ARTICLE APPLICABLE TO A LICENSE AND RACING DAYS AWARDED PURSUANT TO SECTION 7 OF THIS ARTICLE. PUPSUANT TO THE TRANSFER OF THESE RACING DAYS BOWIE RACE COURSE SHALL PROVIDE AT LEAST ONE RACE HORSES WITH A CLAIMING PRICE OF \$1,500 PER DAY FOR THROUGH \$2,500 FOR THE 1975 AND 1976 RACING SEASONS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
