

CHAPTER 777

(House Bill 1137)

AN ACT concerning

State Aid for Public Education - Density Aid Programs
and Declaration of Estimated Income Tax

FOR the purpose of increasing the population density aid per pupil [[to provide compensatory programs for students with special educational needs resulting from educationally or economically disadvantaged environments]], changing the date on or before which an amended declaration of estimated income tax is required to be filed and one-fourth of the estimated tax due is required to be paid, providing for an appropriation for the 1974-1975 fiscal year of the funds necessary for the public education population density aid increase, and relating generally to increasing public education population density aid through advancement of payment of a portion of estimated income tax, providing for a statewide study of funding for compensatory programs for certain students.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 128B of Article 77 - Public Education, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:
