comprise the county Board of Education in Baltimore County shall respectively be residents of the [[seven [senatorial subdistricts] SEVEN COUNCILMATIC DISTRICTS OF BALTIMORE COUNTY] EIGHT LEGISLATIVE DISTRICTS LYING WHOLLY OR PARTLY WITHIN BALTIMORE COUNTY and the remaining [[two members]] ONE MEMBER shall be appointed from the county at large; and any member who does not [retain] MAINTAIN his residential qualification shall [at the time of removing his residence from the district he represents no longer be] BE REPLACED AS a member of the Board. In the event that the boundary line of a [senatorial subdistrict] [[COUNCILMATIC]] LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT is altered, the term of an incumbent member of the Board who is no longer residing in the [subdistrict] [[COUNCILMATIC1]] LEGISLATIVE DISTRICT, because of such change, shall not be affected during the period of this term.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
