CHAPTER 789

(House Bill 1266)

AN ACT concerning

Motor Vehicles -- Title Certificates and Fees

FOR the purpose of requiring registered vehicle dealers of certain motorcycles and trailers to obtain written application for certificate of title and prescribed fees, and forward them to the Motor Vehicle Administration, permitting dealers to receive a certain credit for performing this service, and clarifying language.
