CHAPTER 790

(House Bill 1268)

AN ACT concerning

Montgomery Community College — Vacancies on the Board of Trustees

FOR the purpose of providing for a Nominating Committee to submit nominations to fill vacancies on the Board of Trustees of Montgomery Community College, and restricting to nominees of the Nominating Committee appointments by the Governor to the Board.

BY adding to

Article 77A — Higher Education Section 9C Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That new Section 9C be and it is hereby added to Article 77A — Higher Education, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1969 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) to read as follows:

Article 77A - Higher Education

9C.

(A) DUTIES: COMPOSITION.

IN MONTGOMERY COUNTY, CANDIDATES FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF MONTGOMERY COMMUNITY COLLEGE SHALL BE NOMINATED BY A NOMINATING COMMITTEE WHICH SHALL BE COMPOSED OF FIVE MEMBERS, TWO OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY TWO OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE, AND ONE OF WHOM SHALL BE APPOINTED BY THE MONTGOMERY COMMUNITY COLLEGE ALUMNI ASSOCIATION.

(B) QUALIFICATIONS; TERM; CHAIRMAN.

EACH MEMBER OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE SHALL BE A RESIDENT AND REGISTERED VOTER OF MONTGOMERY COUNTY, AND SHALL HAVE KNOWLEDGE OF AND INTEREST IN POST—SECONDARY EDUCATION AND SHALL HAVE DEMONSTRATED AN ACTIVE INTEREST IN CIVIC AFFAIRS. NO PERSON MAY BE A MEMBER OF THE NOMINATING COMMITTEE WHO IS AN OFFICER OR EMPLOYEE OF MONTGOMERY COMMUNITY COLLEGE OR OTHERWISE SUBJECT TO THE
