

NAMED BY MARYLAND STATUTE WAS A PRIOR CONDITION FOR LEGAL SALE WITHIN MARYLAND AT THE TIME THE VEHICLE WAS MANUFACTURED, THE PRESENCE OF SUCH EQUIPMENT SHALL NOT BE REQUIRED AS A CONDITION FOR CURRENT LEGAL USE OF ANY VEHICLE REGISTERED UNDER PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION. ANY SUCH VEHICLE IS EXEMPTED FROM STATUTES REQUIRING PERIODIC VEHICLE INSPECTIONS, AND FROM STATUTES REQUIRING THE INSPECTION AND USE OF EMISSION CONTROLS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

AN ACT concerning

Washington County -- Obsolete Code Provisions
