The approval of at least fifty-one percent (51%) of the counties participating in the regional community college shall be required before all the participating counties approve the budget, and such be binding on all the participating shall counties. Each community college shall submit budget, including personnel detail, to the State Board for Community Colleges for informational purposes. board of trustees shall be styled "The board of trustees of community (or junior) college" and it may adopt Except for regional community corporate seal. colleges, the chairman of the board of education or the board of school commissioners is the chairman of the board of trustees.

The [mayor and city council of Baltimore county commissioners or county council] LOCAL GOVERNING BODY of any county AND BALTIMORE CITY for which a community college or regional community college is established under this subtitle [have the right and power MAY appropriate funds to meet the cost establishment, current expenses, purchase of land, AND construction AND MAINTENANCE of capital improvements[, and the maintenance thereof]. THEY SHALL APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR THE FOLLOWING MAJOR FUNCTIONS: INSTITUTIONAL ADMINISTRATION, GENERAL EXPENSES. INSTRUCTION, STUDENT AFFAIRS, INSTRUCTIONAL RESOURCES, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE, CAPITAL OUTLAYS, AND DEBT SERVICE. THE COMMUNITY COLLEGE MAY NOT EXPEND FOR AN AMOUNT WHICH EXCEEDS THE APPROPRIATION FUNCTION ANY THAT FUNCTION. ANY TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS BETWEEN MAJOR FUNCTIONS MAY BE MADE ONLY AFTER IT IS SUBMITTED IN WRITING AND APPROVED BY THE LOCAL GOVERNING IF THE LOCAL GOVERNING BODY FAILS TO ACT UPON THE IS APPROVED SUBMISSION WITHIN 30 DAYS, THE TRANSFER PROPOSED. ANY TRANSFER OF APPROPRIATIONS WITHIN A MAJOR FUNCTION MAY BE MADE AT THE DIRECTION OF THE LOCAL BOARD OF COMMUNITY COLLEGE TRUSTEES.
