Article 41 - Governor-Executive and Administrative Departments

THE DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMIC AND COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT, OR THE APPROPRIATE DIVISION THEREOF, SHALL PROMULGATE AND ADOPT A STATE BUILDING CODE FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR MAKING [[ALL]] BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES ACCESSIBLE AND USABLE BY THE PHYSICALLY HANDICAPPED TO THE EXTENT FEASIBLE. THE RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL BE DEVELOPED IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE GOVERNOR'S COMMITTEE FOR EMPLOYMENT OF THE HANDICAPPED, THE MARYLAND REHABILITATION ASSOCIATION, AND THE STATE BOARD OF ARCHITECTS.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

(House Bill 1667)

AN ACT concerning

Age of Majority Identification Cards
