

for ANY [minor] PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE to attempt to purchase any alcoholic beverages or to drink, or have in his or her possession, any alcoholic beverages, EXCEPT BEER AND LIGHT WINE, in any public place or on any public highway. [The word "minor" shall apply to every person under twenty-one years of age, except] THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY to bona fide employees in the course of their employment and whose employment is not prohibited by this article. Any person violating the provisions of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each and every such violation.

181A.

It [shall be] IS unlawful for any [minor] PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE in Prince George's County to have in his possession or to consume any alcoholic beverages, EXCEPT BEER AND LIGHT WINE, IN ANY PUBLIC PLACE OR ON ANY PUBLIC HIGHWAY, AND IT IS UNLAWFUL FOR ANY PERSON UNDER 18 YEARS OF AGE TO HAVE IN HIS POSSESSION OR TO CONSUME ANY BEER OR LIGHT WINE in any public place or on any public highway. [The word "minor" shall apply to every person under 21 years of age, except] THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION DO NOT APPLY TO bona fide employees in the course of their employment and whose employment is not prohibited by this article. Any person violating the provisions of this [subsection] SECTION [shall be] IS guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine of not less than twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) nor more than one hundred dollars (\$100.00) for each violation.

182.

(a) It [shall be] IS unlawful for any minor in St. Mary's County to attempt to purchase alcoholic beverages, or to drink, or have in his possession, any alcoholic beverages, in any public place or on any public highway. The word "minor" shall apply to every person under twenty-one (21) years of age, except bona fide employees in their course of employment and whose employment is not prohibited by this article, and all persons eighteen (18) years of age or older shall be allowed all the rights of a consumer in regard to beer OR LIGHT WINES. Any person violating the provisions of this subsection shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction thereof, shall be subject to a fine not exceeding fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each and every such violation.

(b) It [shall be] IS unlawful for any person to request or induce a [minor] PERSON UNDER 21 YEARS OF AGE to purchase, or to attempt to purchase, any alcoholic
