consumption, exhaust emissions, and over-crowding of parking facilities; and

WHEREAS, The bicycle-riding public should be encouraged to use the streets and highways of Maryland in a safe and responsible manner; and

WHEREAS, It is estimated that there are now as many bicycles in Maryland as there are automobiles; now, therefore.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Sections 11-1201, 11-1202, 11-1203, 11-1204, 11-1205, 11-1205.1, 11-1206 and 11-1207 of Article 66-1/2 - Vehicle Laws, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1970 Replacement Volume and 1973 Supplement) be and they are hereby repealed:

Article 66-1/2 - Vehicle Laws

[11-1201.

- (a) It is a misdemeanor for any person to do any act forbidden or fail to perform any act required in this part.
- (b) The parent of any child and the guardian of any ward shall not authorize or knowingly permit the child or ward to violate any of the provisions of this part.
- (c) The provisions of this part applicable to bicycles apply whenever a bicycle is operated upon any highway or upon any path set aside for the exclusive use of bicycles, subject to those exceptions stated herein.

11-1202.

Every person riding a bicycle upon a roadway shall be granted all of the rights and subject to all of the duties applicable to the driver of a vehicle by this subtitle, except as to special regulations in this part and except as to those provisions of this article which by their nature can have no application.

11-1203.

- (a) A person propelling a bicycle shall not ride other than upon or astride a permanent and regular seat attached thereto.
- (b) No bicycle shall be used to carry more persons at one time than the number for which it is designed or
