CHAPTER 871

(House Bill 767)

AN ACT concerning

Drivers - Reports on Physical Condition

FOR the purpose of amending the law requiring physicians and certain other persons to report certain facts about certain people to the Motor Vehicle Administration; providing that this reporting procedure is permissive; prohibiting certain reports; repealing the time limit for the filing of a report; limiting the present immunity provided to those who file reports by requiring that certain confidential or privileged relationships are not violated; and correcting language.
