A House Joint Resolution concerning

Charles County Courthouse - Salaries of Non-Elected Employees

FOR the purpose of requesting the Secretary of the State
Department of Personnel to survey and recommend
salaries and pay scales for the non-elected
employees in the Courthouse of Charles County.

WHEREAS, The salaries and pay scales of the non-elected employees in the Charles County Courthouse have not kept pace with inflation and modern requirements; and

WHEREAS, The salaries and pay scales of state employees have kept pace with inflation and modern requirements; and

WHEREAS, A large percentage of other public employees in Charles County have salaries and pay scales that are comparable to those of State employees; and

WHEREAS, This inequitable situation results in low morale and personnel instability on the part of the non-elected employees in the Charles County Courthouse; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Mr. Henry G. Bosz, Secretary of Personnel, be requested to survey the salaries and positions of the non-elected employees of the Courthouse of Charles County and recommend appropriate salaries and pay scales utilizing State standards; and be it further
