Senate Bill 870, which was enacted by the General Assembly and signed by me on April 30, 1974, contains a comprehensive revision of the laws relating to environmental noise control. In its revision, Senate Bill 870 repeals those provisions of Article 43 relating to the Noise Pollution Control Advisory Council and creates an Environmental Noise Advisory Council in its place.

Because of the inconsistency between the two bills, I have decided to veto House Bill 651.
