Dear Governor Mandel:

Pursuant to the responsibility placed on the Joint Standing Committee on Administrative, Executive and Legislative Review by Chapter 1 of the Acts of the Second Special Session of the General Assembly of Maryland of 1973, the Committee must receive and consider Executive Orders promulgated by virtue of the presently existing energy crisis.

On November 19, 1973, the members of the Committee received copies of the Executive Order which authorizes the Director of the Energy Policy Office to prepare an inventory of present and projected supplies of and needs for various energy resources within the State.

On November 20, 1973, in a meeting open to the press and to the public, the Committee received testimony on the Executive Order. Following the testimony and after appropriate discussion, a motion was made and seconded to approve the Executive Order as written. The recorded roll-call vote on the motion was as follows:
