Resolution shall be published in the "Evening Capital", a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Annapolis, or in any other newspaper of such general circulation, once in each of the weeks, March 26, April 2, April 9, April 16, and April 23, 1973.

SECTION III: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS that the Mayor is hereby specifically commanded to carry out the provisions of Section II hereof, and, as evidence of such compliance, the Mayor shall cause to be affixed to the Minutes of this meeting appropriate certificates of publication of the newspaper or newspapers in which the title of the Resolution shall have been published and shall declare the Charter change hereby enacted to be effective on May 8, 1973, or following a favorable referendum thereon, by affixing his signature hereto in the space provided on the effective date of change.

SECTION IV: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND ALDERMEN OF THE CITY OF ANNAPOLIS that as soon as the Charter amendment hereby enacted shall become effective, either as provided herein or following a referendum, the Mayor shall send separately by registered mail, to the Secretary of State of Maryland and to the Department of Legislative Reference of Maryland a clear certified copy of this Resolution showing the number of Aldermen voting for and against it and a report on the votes cast for or against the amendment hereby enacted at any referendum thereon and the date of such referendum.

The above Charter Amendment was enacted by the foregoing Resolution which was passed at a special meeting of the Mayor and Aldermen of the City of Annapolis, March 19, 1973, the Mayor and four (4) Aldermen voting in the affirmative, two (2) Aldermen voting in the negative, one (1) Alderman abstaining, and one (1) Alderman absent, and the said Resolution becomes effective in accordance with law on the 8th day of May, 1973.
