Charter Amendment 73-3

## MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF BRENTWOOD, MARYLAND

A RESOLUTION AND ORDINANCE to amend Sections 6-29, 6-30 and 6-31 of the Code of Public Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland, (1963 Edition), titled "Brentwood" and subtitled "Tax for Fire Department", "Same; collection" and "Borrowing power for Fire Department", respectively, by repealing same.

BE IT RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND TOWN COUNCIL OF BRENTWOOD, MARYLAND, that Sections 6-29, 6-30 and 6-31 of the Code of Public Laws of Prince George's County, Maryland (1963) Edition), titled "Brentwood" and subtitle "Tax for Fire Department", "Same; collection" and "Borrowing power for Fire Department", respectively, being part of the Charter of the Town of Brentwood, Maryland, be and the same are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Mayor and Town Council of Brentwood, Maryland, that any section or sections of the Charter of the Town of Brentwood, Maryland, which are inconsistent with the above enacted Section, be and the same are hereby repealed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Mayor and Town Council of Brentwood, Maryland, that the foregoing proposed amendment shall be posted in the Town Hall for a period of at least forty (40) days following its adoption, and shall further be published in the paper of record once in each of four successive weeks before the 14th day of January, 1974.
