CHARTER AMENDMENT

RESOLUTION of the Commissioners of Cambridge adopted pursuant to the authority of Article 11E of the Constitution of Maryland and Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Replacement Volume) entitled "Corporation - Municipal" to amend the Charter of The Commissioners of Cambridge by enacting new Section 32A entitled "Voting Machines", of the Code of Public Local Laws of Dorchester County (1961 Edition), said Code being Article 10 of the Public Local Laws of Maryland, entitled "Dorchester County", subtitled "Cambridge", providing for the use of voting machines in elections.

SECTION 1. BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMISSIONERS OF CAMBRIDGE that the Charter of said municipal corporation be, and the same is hereby amended by enacting Section 32A to read as follows:

32A. VOTING MACHINES. IN ALL ELECTIONS HELD IN THE CITY OF CAMBRIDGE VOTING MACHINES ARE PERMITTED TO BE USED AND ANY REFERENCE TO THE USE OF BALLOTS HEREINAFTER CONTAINED APPLIES EQUALLY TO THE USE OF VOTING MACHINES WITH BALLOT LABELS THEREON.

SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this Resolution shall become effective the 12th day of March, 1974.
