thereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLLEGE PARK, MARYLAND, that the proposed amendment will come and be considered part of the municipal charter of the City of College Park on the 14th day of November, 1973, unless a petition is filed pursuant to Article 23A, Section 13 of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1957 Edition, as amended, said petition to be filed on or before the 4th day of November, 1973.

## CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION NO. 58
