SAID BORROWING, FOR ANY PROPER PUBLIC PURPOSE AND TO EVIDENCE SUCH BORROWING BY ITS NOTE OR NOTES AT SUCH INTEREST RATES AND UPON SUCH TERMS AND CONDITIONS AS THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL MAY DEEM IN THE BEST INTERESTS OF THE CITY. THE PAYMENT OF SUCH INDEBTEDNESS SHALL BE SUBJECT TO THE TERMS AND PROVISIONS OF SECTION 231 OF THE CITY CHARTER.

SECTION 2: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the date of the passage of this Resolution is March 19, 1973, and the amendment to the Charter of the City of Frostburg, hereby enacted, shall become effective on May 8, 1973, unless a proper Petition for a Referendum hereon shall be filed as provided by Section 13 of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, and provided a complete and exact copy of this Resolution shall be continuously posted on the entrance of the City Hall, Frostburg, Maryland, until May 8, 1973, and provided further that a fair summary of the proposed amendment shall be published in the Cumberland Evening Times, a newspaper of general circulation in the City of Cumberland, once in each of the weeks of 3/19, 3/26, 4/24/9.

SECTION 3: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That the Mayor of the City of Frostburg is hereby specifically directed to carry out the provisions of Section 2 hereof, regarding the giving of notice by posting and publication this Resolution approving the same, and, as evidence of said compliance, the City Clerk shall cause to be affixed hereto a certificate of publication of newspaper in which the summary of this Resolution have been published, and the Mayor, if there is no Petition for a Referendum, shall declare the Charter Amendment made to be effective on the effective date herein provided for, which is May 8, by affixing signature hereto in the space provided below effective date hereof.

SECTION 4: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That, if a proper Petition for a Referendum on the Charter Amendment herein proposed is filed, the Mayor and other proper officials of the City of Prostburg shall comply with all of the provisions set forth in Sections 13 to 17, both inclusive, of Article 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland.

SECTION 5: AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That as soon as the Charter Amendment hereby made shall become effective, either as herein provided or following a Referendum, the Mayor shall send separately, by
