THE CITY COUNCIL.

- (3) PRESIDENT, DUTIES AND POWERS. THE PRESIDENT OF THE COUNCIL SHALL BE THE CHIEF ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER OF THE CITY AND SHALL BE SUPERVISE THE ACTIVITIES OF ALL DEPARTMENTS OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT EXCEPT THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE. HE SHALL, TOGETHER WITH THE TREASURER, PREPARE THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY AND SUBMIT IT TO THE COUNCIL FOR APPROVAL. HE SHALL PRESIDE AT ALL MEETINGS OF THE COUNCIL, AND SHALL SIGN ALL CONTRACTS, DEEDS, OR OTHER INSTRUMENTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF FRUITLAND. HE SHALL MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS TO THE COUNCIL FOR THE APPOINTMENT OF PERSONS TO FILL VACANCIES AMONG THE HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, OR IN SUCH OTHER OFFICES AS MAY HEREAFTER BE CREATED BY ORDINANCE.
- (4) TREASURER, DUTIES AND POWERS. THE TREASURER SHALL HEAD THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE AND SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE COLLECTION OF ALL TAXES AND OTHER MONEYS DUE THE CITY, AND THE VERIFICATION OF AND PAYMENT OF ALL ACCOUNTS. HE SHALL WITH THE PRESIDENT, PREPARE THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF THE CITY. HE SHALL RECOMMEND TO THE COUNCIL THE SELECTION OF THE INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTANT WHO SHALL AUDIT THE CITY'S BOOKS AND ACCOUNTS. HE SHALL REPORT TO THE COUNCIL ONCE EACH MONTH ON THE STATE OF THE CITY FINANCES, AND SHALL REPORT TO THE COUNCIL QUARTERLY ON THE STATUS OF THE CURRENT BUDGET. HE SHALL SUPERVISE THE WORK OF THE EMPLOYEES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF FINANCE. HE SHALL GIVE BOND TO THE CITY OF FRUITLAND, WITH SUCH SURETY OR SURETIES AS THE COUNCIL MAY REQUIRE, IN SUCH AMOUNT AS THE COUNCIL MAY REQUIRE, BUT NOT LESS THAN THE MINIMUM SUM OF FIFTY-THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00). THE COST OF SAID BOND AND THE COST OF ANY OTHER EMPLOYEE BONDS SHALL BE PAID OUT OF MUNICIPAL FUNDS, AND SUCH BOND OR BONDS SHALL BE DEPOSITED WITH THE CITY CLERK.

SECTION 110 A.

OTHER OFFICES: COUNCILHEN MAY BE ASSIGNED BY ACTION OF THE COUNCIL, SPECIAL LIAISON DUTIES BETWEEN THE COUNCIL AND DEPARTMENT HEADS DURING ANY PERIOD IN WHICH THERE IS NO CITY MANAGER. A COUNCILMAN SO ASSIGNED SHALL FULLY ACQUAINT HIMSELF WITH THE OPERATION OF THE DEPARTMENT, OR DEPARTMENTS, TO WHICH HE IS ASSIGNED AND SHALL CONSULT WITH THE DEPARTMENT HEAD ON SPECIAL PROBLEMS AND POLICIES RELATING TO HIS DEPARTMENT. NOTHING HEREIN CONTAINED HOWEVER, SHALL INTERFERE WITH OR RESTRICT THE RIGHT OF THE DEPARTMENT HEAD TO COMMUNICATE DIRECTLY WITH THE COUNCIL OR THE MEMBERS THEREOF. COUNCILMEN MAY ALSO BE ASSIGNED BY ACTION OF THE COUNCIL OR TO SERVE AS THE REPRESENTATIVE OF THE CITY ON COUNTY—WIDE OR AREA BOARDS OR COMMISSIONS.
