be and the same is hereby repealed, and the following subsection (a) is enacted and adopted in lieu thereof:

"(A) COMMENCING IN THE YEAR 1973, THE ELECTION FOR MAYOR SHALL BE HELD ON THE FIRST MONDAY OF MAY IN EACH ODD-NUMBERED YEAR, AND THE PERSON SO ELECTED SHALL SERVE AS MAYOR FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS OR UNTIL HIS SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES. AT THE SAME ELECTION HELD IN EACH ODD-NUMBERED YEAR, ONE COUNCILMAN SHALL BE ELECTED AND HE SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS OR UNTIL HIS SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES. COMMENCING IN MAY, 1974, ONE COUNCILMAN SHALL BE ELECTED AT AN ELECTION HELD ON THE FIRST MONDAY OF MAY IN EACH EVEN-NUMBERED YEAR AND HE SHALL SERVE FOR A TERM OF TWO YEARS OR UNTIL HIS SUCCESSOR IS ELECTED AND QUALIFIES. ANY APPOINTMENT OR ELECTION TO FILL A VACANCY OCCURRING BEFORE THE EXPIRATION OF A TERM SHALL BE FOR THE REMAINDER OF THE EXPIRED TERM."

The other subsection, viz. subsection (b), of section 3 of the Charter shall remain unaffected by this amendment.

The above amendment shall take effect on the fiftieth (50th) day after the adoption of this resolution, unless a petition to submit the amendment on referendum to the voters of the Town is submitted as prescribed in §13 of Art. 23A of the Annotated Code of Maryland, 1966 replacement volume.
