-17.60.Regulations - To adopt by ordinance and enforce within the corporate limits, police, health, sanitary, fire, building, traffic, parking and other similar regulations not in conflict with the laws of the State of Maryland or this Charter.

-17.61.Salaries - To fix the salary or compensation of all elected and appointed municipal officials and employees of the Town.

-17.62.Sewerage and Drainage Systems -- To construct and maintain sewerage and storm drainage systems not provided by Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission or other agencies of the State of Maryland.

-17.63.Sidewalks - To regulate the use of sidewalks; to require the owner or occupant of premises to keep the sidewalks in front thereof free from snow or other obstructions, including but not limited to overhanging hedges, weeds and brush.

-17.64.Streets - To regulate, control, open, close and maintain all dedicated public streets.

-17.65.Street and Sidwalk Improvement - To regulate and improve curbs, streets, gutters, sidewalks, driveways, and assess the property owners for any necessary costs of construction and/or to require bond for property owners or the construction agents to meet specified standards.

-17.66.Sweepings - To regulate or prevent the throwing of depositing of sweepings, dust, ashes, offal, garbage, paper, handbills, dirty liquids, oils, grease and volatile liquids, or other automobile refuse or any unwholesome materials whatsoever into any public way or on any public or private property in the Town, including gutters, sewers, catch basins, ditch or stream.

-17.67.Tax Exemptions - To allow certain tax exemptions from the Town property tax to certain senior and disabled citizens.

-17.68.Television -- To license and/or franchise community antenna or other subscription television systems, or enter into agreements with other agencies for the same.

-17.69.Trees - To provide for the setting out of trees, their trimming, spraying and removal on or along any street, sidewalk, alley or lane.

-17.70.Voting machines - To purchase, lease, borrow, install and maintain voting machines for use in Town elections.
