Boulevard and on the north side of Middle Neck Branch; thence still by and with the corporate limit and the north side of Middle Neck Branch in an easterly direction to the point of beginning.

RESOLUTION NO. 171

A RESOLUTION of the Council of The City of Salisbury proposing the annexation to the City of Salisbury of a certain area of land situated contiguous to and binding upon the Southeasterly corporate limits of the City of Salisbury popularly known as the Glen Avenue Annexation No. 2 and bounded on the Northwest by the existing corporate limits of the City of Salisbury and bounded on the Southwest in part by the Southerly line of Glen Avenue and in part by the Northerly line of North Park Drive and the existing corporate limits and bounded on the Southeast by the Northwesterly line of Beaglin Park Drive and bounded on the North in part by the Southerly line of U.S. Route 50 and the Northerly line of the property of Wicomico County Board of Education and providing for conditions and circumstances applicable to the proposed changes in boundary of the City Salisbury.

WHERBAS, The City of Salisbury has received consents to annexation signed by at least 25% of the persons who reside in the area to be annexed and who are registered voters and by the owners of at least 25% of the assessed valuation of the real property located in the area sought to be annexed, being contiguous to and binding upon the Southwesterly corporate limits of The City of Salisbury and called "Glen Avenue Annexation No. 2", for identification, and

WHEREAS, The City of Salisbury has caused to be made a certification of the signatures on said consent to annexation and has verified that the persons signing the petition represent at least 25% of the persons who reside in the area to be annexed and who are registered to vote in the county elections for Wicomico County, in which said area is located and that the persons signing the consent to annexation are the owners of at least 25% of the assessed valuation of the real property located in the area sought to be annexed, all as of June 19, 1973, as will more particularly appear by the certification of Philip C. Cooper, Director of Public Works for The City of Salisbury, attached hereto; and

WHEREAS, it appears that the consents meet all the
