(59) BUYER. GRADUATION FROM A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE OF RECOGNIZED STANDING AND ONE (1) YEAR OF EXPERIENCE IN THE PURCHASING OF A VARIETY OF STANDARD SUPPLIES, MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(60) BUYER, ASSOCIATE. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL, PREFERABLY COMPLETION OF A TWO (2) YEAR COMMUNITY OR JUNIOR COLLEGE PROGRAM OR TWO (2) YEARS OF COLLEGE TRAINING; TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE PURCHASING OF A VARIETY OF STANDARD SUPPLIES, MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(61) BUYER, SENIOR. GRADUATION FROM A UNIVERSITY OR COLLEGE OF RECOGNIZED STANDING AND THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN PURCHASING A WIDE VARIETY OF COMMODITIES, ONE (1) YEAR OF WHICH EXPERIENCE MUST HAVE BEEN AT THE LEVEL OF BUYER; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(62) CAPTAIN, FIRE. COMPLETION OF TWO (2) YEARS OF ACCEPTABLE COLLEGE TRAINING AND FOUR (4) YEARS OF PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE SERVICE IN A FIRE DEPARTMENT; OR COMPLETION OF ONE (1) YEAR OF ACCEPTABLE COLLEGE TRAINING AND FIVE (5) YEARS OF PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE SERVICE IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT; OR GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL AND SEVEN (7) YEARS OF PROGRESSIVELY RESPONSIBLE SERVICE IN A FIRE DEPARTMENT; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(63) CAPTAIN, POLICE. COMPLETION OF TWO (2) YEARS OF ACCEPTABLE COLLEGE TRAINING AND SIX (6) YEARS OF
