

COUNTY LOCAL LAWS

OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(197) MASON. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AS A JOURNEYMAN MASON; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(198) MECHANIC, AUTOMOTIVE I. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; PREFERABLY INCLUDING COURSES IN AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE; TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AS A TRADES HELPER, GARAGE, OR SERVICE STATION ATTENDANT OR CLOSELY RELATED WORK; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF TRAINING AND EXPERIENCE. POSSESSION OF A MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

(199) MECHANIC, AUTOMOTIVE II. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AT THE LEVEL OF AUTOMOTIVE MECHANIC I OR AS A JOURNEYMAN AUTOMOTIVE MECHANIC; PREFERABLY INCLUDING SOME EXPERIENCE IN DIESEL ENGINE AND HYDRAULIC SYSTEMS REPAIR WORK; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE. POSSESSION OF A MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

(200) MECHANIC, AUTOMOTIVE III, GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; FOUR (4) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN AUTOMOTIVE, INDUSTRIAL AND HEAVY DUTY EQUIPMENT REPAIR, TWO (2) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE MUST BE IN THE REPAIR OF DIESEL ENGINES, HUDRAULICS, AND HIGH PRESSURE PUMP SYSTEMS; PREFERABLY SOME EXPERIENCE IN THE REPAIR OF FIRE FIGHTING EQUIPMENT, OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE. POSSESSION OF A VALID MARYLAND MOTOR VEHICLE OPERATOR'S LICENSE.

(201) MECHANIC, AUTOMOTIVE, FOREMAN. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL, PREFERABLY INCLUDING COURSES IN AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE; THREE (3) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN THE REPAIR AND MAINTENANCE OF AUTOMOTIVE EQUIPMENT WHICH INCLUDED TRUCKS, HYDRAULIC SYSTEMS AND HEAVY CONSTRUCTION EQUIPMENT; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(202) MECHANIC, MAINTENANCE I. COMPLETION OF THE EIGHTH (8TH) GRADE, PREFERABLY GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; AND FOUR (4) YEARS OF EXPERIENCE IN ONE (1) OR MORE OF THE BUILDING OR MECHANICAL TRADES AS RELATED TO BUILDING MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS; OR ANY EQUIVALENT COMBINATION OF EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE.

(203) MECHANIC, MAINTENANCE II. GRADUATION FROM A RECOGNIZED HIGH SCHOOL; THREE (3) YEARS OF JOURNEYMAN EXPERIENCE IN ONE (1) OR MORE OF THE BUILDING OR
