thence northwest on Route #28 to its intersection with Quince Orchard Road (Md. Route #124); thence northeasterly along Route #124 to Longdraft Road; thence north on Longdraft Road to Long Draught Branch; thence west with Long Draught Branch to Great Seneca Creek; thence north with Great Seneca Creek to Clopper Road; thence northwest along Clopper Road to Old Germantown at Route #118; thence northeast on Route #118 to Route #355; thence north on Route #355 to Brink Road; thence southeast on Brink Road to the Town of Laytonsville; thence easterly along Route #420 (Sundown Road) to Unity; thence easterly along Damascus Road to Route #97; thence southerly along Route #97 to Olney; thence easterly along Route #103 to Ashton; thence southerly along Route #650 to Ednor Road; thence northeast on Ednor Road to the Montgomery County-Howard County boundary line; thence with the Montgomery County-Howard County boundary line to the Montgomery County-Prince George's County boundary line; thence with the Montgomery County-Prince George's County boundary line to the Montgomery County-District of Columbia boundary line; thence with the Montgomery County-District of Columbia boundary line to the place of beginning.

Sec. 2. This Act shall take effect on the 76th day following the day on which it becomes law.

 Chapter 30

AN ACT to amend Chapter 27, title "In General," "Subtitle 1. Fire Tax Areas," by adding a new Section 27-32, title "Length of Service Award Program," to recognize the valuable contribution made by the active volunteers within the Fire/Rescue Service of Montgomery County, Maryland by providing that any volunteer who has completed twenty-five (25) years of certified active service upon reaching age 62 shall receive a payment of \$100 per month for life; to provide for the method of funding of such payments by the several departments and rescue squads from County tax funds or from the funds of such departments; to establish the procedures for the administration of the program and certification of eligible recipients by the Personnel Committee of the Montgomery County Fire Board, including rights of appeal; and to set forth active membership standards using a point system which each volunteer shall meet annually for twenty-five (25) years in
