Minimum number of calls volunteer must run annually in order 25 50 75 100 to receive 15 points credit.

(7) Military Service.

A member whose voluntary fire service is interrupted by full-time extended obligatory military service or by a single voluntary enlistment not to exceed four years in the armed forces of the United States shall be considered on military leave. During such period of military leave, the volunteer shall receive active volunteer service credit of fifty (50) points for each full year, pro-rated for service of less than a full year.

Sec. 2. Severability.

The provisions of this Act are severable and if any provision, sentence, clause, section or part thereof is held illegal, invalid or unconstitutional or inapplicable to any person or circumstances, such illegality, invalidity or unconstitutionality, inapplicability shall not affect or impair any of the remaining provisions, sentences, clauses, sections or parts of the Act or their application to other persons or circumstances. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Act would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional provision, sentence, clause, section or part had not been included therein, and if the person or circumstances to which the Act or any part thereof is inapplicable had been specifically exempted therefrom.

Sec. 3. Effective date.

This Act shall take effect on the 76th day following the date it becomes law.

Chapter 32

AN ACT to amend Chapter 79, titled "Building Code," of the Montgomery County Code 1965, as amended by repealing and re-enacting, with amendments Sec. 79-21. titled "Section 118.2. Fees-Schedule," to
