

13-118. PATENT NOT TO AFFECT RIPARIAN RIGHTS, NOR ISSUE FOR LAND COVERED BY NAVIGABLE WATERS.

NO PATENT ISSUED IMPAIRS OR AFFECTS THE RIPARIAN RIGHTS OF OTHER PERSONS, AND NO PATENT MAY BE ISSUED FOR LAND COVERED BY NAVIGABLE WATERS.

13-119. COPIES OF RECORD BOOKS PRIOR TO 1787.

THE ARCHIVIST MAY DEMAND ANY RECORD BOOK PRIOR TO 1787 FROM ANY CLERK OF THE COURT, FOR COPYING PURPOSES AFTER GIVING HIM A RECEIPT FOR IT. HOWEVER, THE ARCHIVIST MAY NOT KEEP THE RECORD LONGER THAN IS NECESSARY FOR THIS PURPOSE AND NOT EXCEEDING 60 DAYS. THE ARCHIVIST SHALL RETURN THE RECORD TO THE CLERK OF COURT AND THE EXPENSE OF TRANSPORTATION AND INSURANCE SHALL BE BORNE BY THE ARCHIVIST.

REVISOR'S NOTE: This section presently appears as Art. 21, §13-117 of the Code. In the first sentence the phrase "in the State of Maryland" is proposed for deletion to conform to the Commission's style guidelines. The only other changes are in style.

13-120. FEES FOR ISSUING PATENTS.

THE ARCHIVIST SHALL COLLECT AND REMIT TO THE STATE TREASURY ALL MONEY RECEIVED FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A PATENT FOR VACANT LAND AND THE FOLLOWING FEES:

(1) FOR THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION FOR WARRANT AND THE ISSUANCE OF THE WARRANT, A FEE OF \$20 PLUS A FEE EQUAL TO THE AMOUNT CHARGED FOR POSTAGE ON ANY NOTICES OF WARRANT REQUIRED TO BE MAILED BY THE ARCHIVIST.

(2) FOR ISSUING A DUPLICATE OR AMENDED WARRANT, A FEE OF \$5.

(3) FOR EXAMINING AND FILING ANY CERTIFICATE OR AMENDED CERTIFICATE OF A SURVEYOR, A FEE OF \$2 PER PAGE.

(4) FOR PREPARATION, ISSUANCE, AND RECORDING A PATENT, A FEE OF \$3 PER PAGE.

(5) FOR CERTIFIED COPIES OF ANY RECORDS, A SINGLE CHARGE IF A COPY IS SUPPLIED, OR A FEE OF \$1 PER PAGE IF THE ARCHIVIST PREPARES THE COPY TO BE CERTIFIED.
