(Senate Bill 331)

AN ACT concerning

Allegany County - Salaries of County Commissioners

FOR the purpose of increasing the basic salaries of the county commissioners of Allegany County, repealing their additional compensation when acting as road commissioners, making a stylistic change in language, and resolving any question concerning the legality of Chapter 477 of the Acts of 1973.

By repealing Sections 45 and 46 as they appear in the 1973 Supplement to the Code of Public Local Laws of Allegany County.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,
