

Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene, and by and with the advice and consent of the Senate of Maryland shall appoint [nine] ELEVEN licensed funeral directors and embalmers, residents of the State of Maryland, who shall have been actively engaged in their profession for the last five years immediately preceding their appointment, [four] FIVE of whom shall be residents of Baltimore City and [five] SIX residents of the counties, who, together with the Commissioner of Health, or some person designated by the said Commissioner, as an ex officio member, shall constitute the State Board of Funeral Directors and Embalmers of Maryland, and they shall take oath prescribed by the Constitution of Maryland. The members of the said Board shall hold office for a term of four (4) years or until their successors are duly appointed and qualified; any vacancy or vacancies occurring in the membership of the said Board appointed by the Governor shall be filled by the Governor, upon the recommendations of the Secretary of Health and Mental Hygiene and by and with the advice and consent of the Senate of Maryland.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
