

Section 8-106(b)

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 8-106(b) of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Volume) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

8-106.

(b)

A juror shall receive the following per diem amount for each day he attends court as a juror:

(1) Allegany County - \$10; a juror who resides outside the corporate limits of Cumberland shall receive 10 cents per mile or fraction of a mile actually traveled going to and from court each day over the shortest practicable route.

(2) Anne Arundel County - \$15; no mileage allowance, no overtime.

(3) Baltimore City - \$10; no mileage allowance, no overtime.

(4) Baltimore County - the [compensation] EXPENSE MONEY AS set by the judges of the Circuit Court of Baltimore County.

(5) Calvert County - \$10 expense money plus an additional \$5 expense money if his service extends past 6:00 P.M. and a second additional \$5 if his service extends past 9:00 P.M. on any day.

(6) Caroline County - \$10; no mileage allowance, no overtime.

(7) Carroll County - \$15.

(8) Cecil County - \$7.50; 15 cents mileage allowance.

(9) Charles County - \$10 expense money plus an additional \$5 expense money if his service extends past 6:00 P.M. and a second additional \$5 if his service extends past 9:00 P.M. on any day.
