AN ACT concerning

Frederick County - Bailiffs

FOR the purpose of providing that bailiffs in Frederick County shall be paid a compensation as set by the County Commissioners of that County.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 2-506 of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1973 Volume) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-506.

(a) A bailiff shall receive the compensation provided in this section. Unless otherwise provided, the amount is a per diem sum for each day he attends the Circuit court.

(1) Allegany County—\$5.

(2) Anne Arundel County—\$15.

(3) Baltimore City—as set by the city government.
