(2) A TERMINATION OF THE TRUST IN ACCORDANCE WITH ITS TERMS, BY ITS EXEAUSTION, BY OPERATION OF LAW, OR OTHERWISE, [LVALIDATES] DOES NOT INVALIDATE THE LEGACY.

4-413. IN TERROREM CLAUSE.

IF FRCEABLE CAUSE EXISTS FOR INSTITUTING PROCEEDINGS, A PROVISION IN A WILL PURPORTING TO PENALIZE AN INTERESTED PERSON FOR CCNTESTING THE WILL OR INSTITUTING CTHER PROCEEDINGS RELATING TO THE ESTATE IS VOID.

SUBTITLE 5. ANATOMICAL GIFT ACT.

4-501. DEFINITIONS.

- (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLIOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INCICATED.
  - (E) ECDY OR PART OF ECDY.

"EODY" OR "PART OF BODY" INCLUDES OFGANS, TISSUES, BONES, ELCCL, AND OTHER EOLY FLUIDS.

(C) LICENSED HOSPITAL.

"LICENSED HOSPITAL" INCLUDES ANY HOSPITAL LICENSED BY THE STATE DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE, AND ANY HOSPITAL OPERATED BY THE UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT, ALTHOUGH NOT REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED UNDER THE LAWS OF THE STATE.

(C) NEXT OF KIN.

"NEXT OF KIN" INCLUDES SPOUSE.

(E) PEFSON.

"PERSON" MEANS ANY INDIVIDUAL, CORPORATION, GOVERNMENT OR GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR SUECIVISION, ESTATE, TRUST, FARTNERSHIP OR ASSOCIATION, OR ANY CTHER LEGAL ENTITY.
