(2) Has, before admission to the examination, completed the course of study in and been graduated from a college or school [or] OF landscape architecture approved by the Board. He shall also submit before admission to the examination evidence of actual practical experience in landscape architectural work of a grade and character satisfactory to the Board. Each complete year of study in such approved college or school of landscape architecture may be accepted in lieu of one year of such experience, and the applicant must submit evidence of sufficient additional acceptable experience to total six years of combined education and experience. In lieu of graduation from an approved college or school of landscape architecture, and the practical experience in addition thereto, an applicant may be admitted to the examination upon presenting evidence of at least eight years of actual, practical experience in landscape architectural work of a grade and character satisfactory to the Board.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.

CHAPTER 164

(Senate Bill 734)

AN ACT concerning

Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages

FOR the purpose of providing that in Harford County if an alcoholic beverage licensee fails to observe the terms of his bond and after due notice, the Liquor Control Board may file a petition for the forfeiture with the Circuit Court for that County; providing for the disposition of the bond; clarifying language; and making this Act an emergency measure.
