CHAPTER 180

(Senate Bill 1086)

AN ACT concerning

Harford County - Compensation of Bailiffs

FOR the purpose of clarifying and changing the limitation on the amount of compensation for a bailiff in the Circuit Court in Harford County.

BY repealing and re-enacting, with amendments,

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That Section 2-506(a) (13) of Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings, of the Annotated Code of Maryland (1974 Volume) be and it is hereby repealed and re-enacted, with amendments, to read as follows:

Article - Courts and Judicial Proceedings

2-506.

(a) A bailiff shall receive the compensation provided in this section. Unless otherwise provided, the amount is a per diem sum for each day he attends the circuit court.

(13) Harford County - As set by the court [but not more than \$2,500 per year for all bailiffs].

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 1974.
