

political agent or treasurer or subtreasurer of any other candidate or political committee, provided, however, that those candidates for party office who are members of the local and State central committees shall not be prohibited from being the treasurer of a central committee during their candidacy. No person shall be appointed or act as treasurer or subtreasurer or political agent in any election or primary election who is not a citizen, resident and registered voter of the State of Maryland.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety and having been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, the same shall take effect from the date of its passage.
