And now he is with at Kent County at the Court house of the town of Chester in said County on the third Tuesday of Nov^r being the Nineteenth day of said Month Anno Domini One thousand Seven hundred thirty and four came the said Geo Clarke and in his proper person appeared and prayed that his and his securitys Recognizance for his appearance as aforesaid might be discharged & ordered by this Court that the same Geo Clarke and his securitys Recognizance for his appearance may be discharged as prayed.
