Ordered by this Court that the fine of the said Sheriff for the use of the County and the Sheriff James and acknowledges the receipt of the same

Ordered by the Court here that Security be given for the said Sheriff thereupon Richard Jackson of the County and planter and Robert Green of the said County planter for and in their proper persons come and acknowledges themselves indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor in the sum of Three Hundred pounds of tobacco each to be made and Leveyd on their body goods and Chatter Lands and tenements to the use of his Lordship his heirs and Successors conditionally that if the said William Aspinwall be not satisfied fees of on the Judgment of and be not satisfied wherewith the said Rich: Jackson & Robt Green acknowledges themselves content

Memorandum Joseph Nicholson of Kent County Gent acknowledges himself Justly Indebted to the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietor of the Province of Maryland his heirs &c in the full and Just sum of Twenty pounds current money of Maryland to be levied on his body goods and Chatter Lands and tenements conditionally that he makes not his personal appearance at the
