to wed her third in day of December being the undevilled day of and month anno  
domini thousand seven hundred and thirty four make reserue that he hath  
here ready twelve shillings by his precept he was commanded and no more  
afterwards to wit the day and year last mentioned come agane the afo  
Lord Proprietor by French Francis his attorney and the afo Daniel Perkins  
by an improper person and the Jurors of Newbury being impeunited  
and called likewise came to wit John Dossart William Earle Thomas  
Pines Baldwin Medford Francis Birney Elton and Robert Roberts  
Benjamin Palmer Joseph Cogington Henry Davis William Woodland  
Abraham Redgrave who being duly & orderly tried and sworn  
to the same the 1<sup>st</sup> of July in the present year upon their oaths do say —  
that the afo Daniel Perkins <sup>the 1<sup>st</sup> of July present in this place</sup> is not guilty of the assault on the afo  
David Crane and by John Derrick <sup>the 1<sup>st</sup> of July present in this place</sup> foreman of the jury  
Therefore it is considered by the Justices here to wit —  
day and year last mentioned that the afo Daniel Perkins afo  
the afo judgment of assault be go thereto without day and also  
it is considered that the said Daniel pay the sum of eight  
shillings ~~for~~ <sup>for</sup> Seventy one pounds of tobacco cost <sup>for</sup> serving  
on the premises afo to the officers of this Court

It is ordered by this Court that the afo of the judgment  
of this Court exhibit and judgment against the  
Daniel Perkins <sup>afo</sup> Daniel for assaulting Captain William  
Crane thereupon James French his law shires attorney in  
this Court and exhibits the Information against the same which is  
as followeth this <sup>1<sup>st</sup></sup> of April in the year of our Lord God seven  
hundred thirty four at the parish <sup>afo</sup> in the County afo within  
the Jurisdiction of this Court made upon a certain William Crane of the  
same County in the peace of God and of the same Lord Proprietary —  
there and there being with force and arms an assault did make  
and the same William then and there did beat wound and scily  
beat so that off his left it was greatly dismised and other harms  
to him then said Crane did to the great damage of the same  
William and against the peace of the same Lord Proprietary —  
that 1200 is his good rule and government — witness —
