 here ready to do in us by his precept he was commanded and now here
 afterwards to wit the day and year last mentioned come againe the said
 Lord Proprietary by Jem. Francis his attorney and the said Daniel Perkins
 by his proper person and the Jurors of the County being impeached
 and called likewise came to wit John Derrick William Yearly Thomas
 James Bidman Medford Francis Barney Eron Alfred Robert Roberts
 Benjamin Palmer Jeseiah Corington Henry Davis William Woodland
 Abraham Redgrave who being duly called tried and sworn
 to the same the truth in the premises upon their oath do say
 that the said Daniel Perkins is not guilty of the assault on the said
 David Crane and by John Derrick the foreman of the jury
 Therefore it is considered by the Justice here to wit the same
 day and year last mentioned that the said Daniel Perkins as to
 the said judgment of assault he go thereof without day and also
 it is considered that the said Daniel pay the sum of eight
 hundred ~~and~~ seventy one pounds of tobacco cost damages
 on the premises aforesaid to the officers of this Court

If His Lordship ordered by this Court that the Clerk of the Judicm^t
 of this Court exhibit an Indictment against the
 Daniel Perkins aforesaid Daniel for assaulting William
 Crane thereupon came Jem. Francis his Lordships attorney in
 this Court and exhibits the Information against the same which is
 as followeth to wit
 The Jurors for the right Honourable the Lord pro:
 prietary that now is for the body of Kent County aforesaid upon their oath
 do present that Daniel Perkins late of Newbury Parish in the County
 aforesaid planter the tenth day of April in the year of our Lord God seven
 teen hundred thirty and four at the parish aforesaid in the County aforesaid within
 the Jurisdiction of this Court in and upon a certain William Crane of the
 same County in the peace of God and of the same Lord Proprietary
 then and there being with force and Arms an assault did make
 and the same William then and there did beat wound and evilly
 treat so that of his life it was greatly impaired and other harms
 to him then and there did to the great damage of the same
 William and against the peace of the same Lord Proprietary
 that now is his good rule and Government. Witness
