Likewise ~~Morgan Huff~~ of Kent County Planter here in Court came and acknowledges himself Indebted to the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of Twelve hundred pounds of Tobacco to be made and conveyed on his body goods and Challee Lands and Tenements to the use of his Said Lordship his heirs & Successors Conditionally that if the said Morgan Huff shall not pay unto the officers of this Court all such Fees as shall accrue on the premises and wherewith the said ~~Morgan Huff~~ acknowledges himself Content

Whereby it is remembered that on the 30 Octob^r 1734 Morgan Huff of Marylandⁱⁿ said County of Kent Planter and Jacob Egan of the same Place African and John Smothers of the same Place Gent^l personally came before me the Subscriber one of the Right Hon^{ble} the Lord Proprietors Justices of the peace for said County to keep assigned and acknowledged to our said Lord Lord Proprietor by the said Morgan Huff in ten pounds and the said Jacob Egan and John Smothers in five pounds Each good & Lawfull money of Great Brittain of their goods and Challee Lands and Tenements Separately to be made & conveyed for the use of his Said Lordship his heirs and Successors if no fault be made in the Condition hereunder written

The Condition of this Recognizance is Such that Whereas the above named Morgan Huff is charged by a certain Sarah Hurley of said County Widow that he had the carnal knowledge of her body and that the said Sarah Hurley is now with Child by him the said Morgan Huff which when born will be a bastard if therefore the said Morgan Huff shall personally appear before the Lordships Justices of the peace at their next County Court to be held at Chester Town in said County the 3 Tuesday in November next then & there to abide & receive what shall be enjoined by the said Court concerning the premises and in the mean time to be of the good Behaviour that then this Recognizance to be void Otherwise not
