come againe to wit the Lord Proprietary by his attorney
and the Jurors of the County being impanelled and
called likewise came to wit John Derrick, Jeremiah Longley
William Parly, Thomas Prior, Bulman, Medford, Francis
Barney, Aron Alford, Robert Roberts, Benjamin Palmer
Henry Davis, William Woodland and Abraham Redgrave
who being duly elected tryd and sworn the same Daniel
in his proper person appearing and the Jurors aforesaid to
say the truth in the premises upon their oath do say that
the aforesaid Daniel Perkins is guilty of the assault on the
abovesaid William Crane the person in the Judgment
aforesaid mentioned and by John Derrick their foreman
all so say

Therefore it is ordered by the Justice
here to wit at West County at the Court house in the Town of
Chesler in said County on the third Tuesday in November being
the ninetieth day of said Month Anno Domini one thousand
seven hundred and thirty four that the aforesaid Daniel Perkins
pay the sum of eight pounds Current money of Maryland
to and for the use of the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary
as a fine for committing the assault aforesaid and also pay
the sum of eight hundred and twenty eight pounds of
Tobacco costs accruing on the premises aforesaid to the Officers of
this Court

John Nevill being summoned as an Evidence in the above
cause comes into Court and proves that he attended two days
as an Evidence in the name for his Lordship against the
aforesaid Daniel Perkins ordered by this Court that the same
Daniel Perkins pay unto the aforesaid John Nevill the sum of
