of Three hundred and twenty two pounds of Tobacco and costs accruing on the
pursuance of the officers of this Court

It is also ORDERED by the Court here at this day to wit the day &
year last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the said Robert
Blackeby into his custody and to execute the punishment in the Judgment
of the Court and afterwards to bring him into Court againe of which
proceet to wit John Gresham Esq. High Sheriff of Kent County makes
return on the day & year last said that he hath executed the punishment
in the Judgment of the Court and also hath here the said Robert Blackeby
before the Court —

Ordered by this Court here that Surety be given for the four pds
and the said Robert Blackeby having not whereof to pay
the same nor any person undertaking for him the Court orders that the
said Robert Blackeby be sold for the payment thereof

Whereupon William Graves of Kent County Esq. and Stephen
Glanville of Kent County Pluror in their proper persons came into Court
and acknowledged themselves indebted to the Right Hon.ble the Lord
Proprietor in the Sum of three pounds ten Shill Current money each
to be made and conveyed on his body goods and Chatter Lands and
tenements to the use of his said Lordship his heirs and Successors —
Conditionally that if they shall not pay unto John Smith the
Sum of forty Shill. & to Robt Harrist thirty Shillings
where with they acknowledge themselves indebted

Likewise William Graves of Kent County Esq. and Stephen Glanville of
Kent County Pluror in their proper persons came into Court and acknowledged
themselves indebted to the Right Hon.ble the Lord Proprietor in the Sum of
two thousand pounds of Tobacco each to be made and conveyed on their
body goods and Chatter Lands & tenements to the use of his said Lordship his
heirs and Successors Conditionally that if they shall not pay the Sum
accruing on the said Indulment and the said Sum accruing and due of
Bond for Stealing from John Smith where with they acknowledge
themselves indebted
