do say that the said Mary Laxum is guilty as she stands indicted and by
Robert L Roberts their Foreman all to say. Therefore it is considered

By the Justices here to wit at Kent County at the Court House in the Town of Chester
in said County on the third day in June being the seventeenth day of said
Month Under Bond one thousand seven hundred and thirty two That the said
Mary Laxum stand half an hour in the pillory and then to have given her on
her back ten lashes well laid on till the blood appear and pay four fold
of the value of the goods aforesaid (which is adjudged to thirty pounds of Tobacco)
The four fold amounting to one hundred and twenty pounds of Tobacco for
her offence for committing the felony aforesaid And also pay the Sum of Ninety
hundred and forty two pounds of Tobacco costs accruing on the
promises aforesaid to the officers of this Court

It is also considered by the Court here at this day to wit the day and Year
last mentioned that the Sheriff of Kent County take the said Mary Laxum into
his Custody and execute the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid and
afterwards to bring her into Court againe of which precept to wit John
Gresham Esquire High Sheriff of Kent County makes Return on the day
Year last said that he hath executed the punishment in the Judgment aforesaid
and also hath here the said Mary Laxum before the Court

Ordered by this Court here that the said Mary Laxum be kept in safe
Custody by the Sheriff of Kent County until the fees accruing on the
promises aforesaid be paid

Kent County Henry Culley acknowledges himself to stand fully indebted
