Town of in said County on the Wednesday in June being the seventeenth
day of said month Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty five
came the said Lord's property by John Francis his attorney and the said
Peter Green in his proper person. And the same Peter Green came
and defends the force and injury whereto. And saith that he is in no
sort guilty of the felony above upon him charged as by the said
Indictment it is alleged and therefore puts himself upon the Country

And he who follows for the said property in like manner saith he is
guilty

The Court's Command was given to the Sheriff of the County that he
Immediately cause to come here twelve or by whom he who neither do
Recognize do. Because as well do. Of which said process the said Sheriff
to wit John Graham could now take at this day to wit the seventeenth
day of June Anno Domini One Thousand Seven hundred and thirty five make
him that he hath here ready to look at by his people he was committed
and now here afterwards to wit the day of Year last mentioned come again
the said Lord's property by John Francis his attorney and the said Peter Green
in his proper person and the Jurors of that Jury being impaneled and
called likewise came to wit Robert Roberts John Carwell Thomas Price
Jordan Conington James Briggold Nicholas Massey Thomas Gold
Alexander Brisco Roger Miller James Moore Glenwell Ralph Francis
