Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary in the sum
of twenty pounds Sterling to be paid and payed on
his body goods and Chattels Lands and tenements to the
use of his said Lordship his heirs and successors conditi
onally that if a certain Richard Combe his servant
should not make his personall appearance at the next
Court to be held for Henr^t County at the Court house in
the Town of Chester in said County on the third —
Wednesday in November present to answer unto what
shall be objected against him on his Lordship's
behalf and in the mean time he is to be of good behavior
wherewith the same Richard Graham acknowledges
himself bound.
